13:44	Matthew	"The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up; then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field." (RSV)

Finally, **remember** the verse itself. With a little practice and repetition, this will become a new habit. It will be a habit of thinking often of God as He is always thinking about you. **Remember** His Word for it brings real meaning to your Life, now and forever.
