1:09	1 John	If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (RSV)
2:08	Ephesians	For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing: it is a gift of God. (NRSV)
