That way when you see that object, you will recall the verse as a remembrance of what God has done for you. It will bring you closer to God as you go about your daily activities.

Word. One definition is: 'a sound or a group sounds that has meaning, and is an independent unit of speech'. We use words all the time. You are reading them now. Words are powerful. Words create emotions. Words can calm or terrify. Words can change history or change lives. Here's what the Bible says when it describes the Word of God:

And God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. Genesis 1:3 (RSV)
Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness;" Genesis 1:26 (RSV)
The LORD exists forever; your word is firmly fixed in heaven. Psalms 119:89 (RSV)
Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Psalms 119:105 (RSV)
In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1 (RSV)
And many more believed because of his (Jesus) word. John 4:41 (RSV)
"Very truly, I tell you, anyone who hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life, and does not come under judgment, but has passed from death to life." John 5:24 (RSV)

God's Word has power and meaning for our lives. Too often we don't read His Word from the Bible and as a result, we don't feel connected to Him. We need His Word in us.

We think there is another way to help link His Word to our everyday activities. We believe that we can measure our time with greater meaning if we will Take Time for God's Word © 2008. This is a Bible Study and Memorization process which allows you to focus on a verse and to remember it as if it were time on a clock. For verses beyond the 24 hours, we can link a verse to an everyday object or event as a frequent reminder about what God has planned for us. With a little practice and repetition, this will become a new habit. It will be a habit of thinking often of God as He is always thinking about you. Remember His Word everyday for it brings real meaning to your life, now and forever. So, Take Time for God's Word.
